



Handy check list for packing

(Please note this is just a guide and not gospel)

soft luggage
trip insurance (with medical coverage)
passport
travel documents
driving lic (if you decide to hire a car)
credit cards (not American Express)
US \$ cash or travellers cheques
name and meeting point of Yacht
Captains name and yacht telephone number
(plus email address)
zip lock bags (very handy)
camera or phone plus waterproof container
batteries if needed
gadgets you cannot do without
sunglasses, glasses and contact lenses
30 + sunscreen NO OIL Based or spray screens(oil stains the decks)
medications, allergy pills, antihistamines
copy of prescriptions
bug repellent
snorkle equipment especially if you have a prescribed glass
Toiletries

t shirts
shorts
swim gear
hats with a clip
cover up
sandals, flip flops
shoes (for hiking exploring)
light waterproof jacket
casual clothes for evenings ashore
sweat shirt or light jumper

Gratuity

ask your broker as lots of yachts accept payments other than cash.

please make sure your broker is informed in plenty time for applying for the fishing licenses.
